SKY RANCH LUTHERAN CAMP 2015 ANNUAL REPORT

BRAD ABBOTT – EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

I will always remember 2015 as the summer of showers at Sky Ranch. Not only was the spring and summer blessed with an abundance of rain bringing an abundance of new growth and incredible wild flowers, but it was also the year that the shower HOUSE was finally replaced! Yes, **on August 29th, the Sky Ranch community gathered to dedicate the new shower house.** It was an occasion to honor the past and celebrate the future of this ministry.



The shower house and its infrastructure was one of several **property improvements** that happened at Sky Ranch in 2015. Numerous volunteers contributed hundreds of hours of labor and donated tons (literally tons) of materials to improve other camp facilities. Upgrades included: new trusses and roof for the nurse's cabin; new picnic tables, beverage bar, entry ramp, and stairway for Christ Lodge; new heaters, bunks and lights in several camper cabins; new bell tower for the backpack center; and new windows and a deck for one of the staff cabins. We also welcomed Dan Arndt as our seasonal maintenance coordinator.

These facility improvements are necessary as our **camper and retreat numbers** continue to grow. While our high school off-site campers were down this past summer, our on-site and retreat numbers continued to increase. On-site campers were up 14% and retreat/weekend use is now over 45% of our overall use. With all the various programs and retreats, Sky Ranch was able to impact the lives of over 3,000 individuals last year.

Places like Sky Ranch are a vital for the church as we strive to proclaim the "Good News" in a culture that decrees

doom and gloom. The loudest voices of today's society tend to affirm fear, legalism, exclusion, and violence, and these voices prevent us from proclaiming a vision of life together that illumines God's intention for us. Sky Ranch helps campers (and staff) find and strengthen their voice. In this remote setting, they are empowered to speak a theological language of hope, grace, inclusion, reconciliation and compassion, living into our vocational call as people of faith.

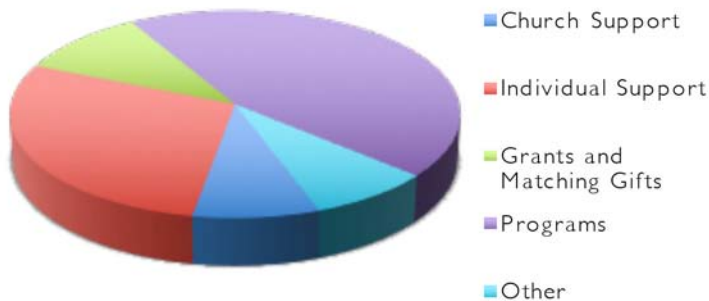
Financially this was a mixed year for Sky Ranch. Because of the National Youth Gathering in Detroit our high school numbers were down and so was the anticipated income from those programs. As a result the annual operating budget finished behind for the year. But with the completion of the new \$400,000 shower house portion of the 50th Anniversary Special Appeal, the balance sheet reflects a positive financial picture for the past year. I am so grateful for all of the people that support this ministry.

As you read through this report you will get a glimpse of some of the individuals that make Sky Ranch happen. So "Thank (continued page 2)

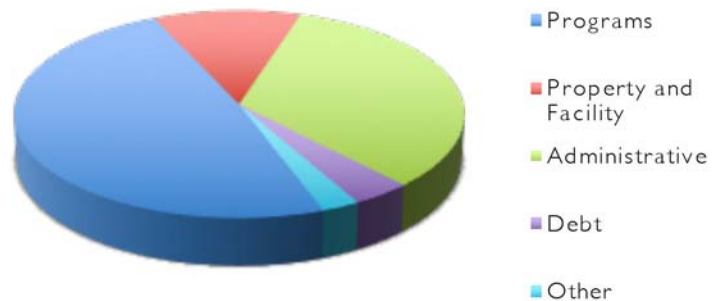

I can distinctly still remember the first trip I made up to camp – it was with former board member, Deborah Price. Our home church, Zion was doing a campaign for one of the cabin renovations and I was asked to be a part of the fundraising. We took the trip up the mountain, leaving Loveland that morning and taking the Buckhorn route. To this day, my favorite spot in Colorado is along that road – just as you get to the camp side of the pass and the valley opens up – it takes your breath away.

As our girls have grown up, we've moved from being in the campground, to our kids being campers in the summer program, and maybe someday being camp counselors. We have loved bringing other families up to stay with

us in the campground and experience all of the beauty around Sky Ranch. Our girls have turned into camp advocates as well, having friends from school join them for the week long "Christ on the Mountaintop" camper experience.

I was honored a few years ago to be able to speak at the 50th Anniversary dinner to share what camp has meant to me. I'm a firm believer that God doesn't call the qualified, he qualifies the called. When I talk about camp, I fully believe that if we can get people up the mountain – the Holy Spirit will do the rest. Our introduction to faith, to camp, to our beliefs is always good enough – God does the rest. And God has done great work with lots of the folks that have been up the mountain. Sky Ranch, like a lot of camps, is where many pastors feel the call for the first time.

Term limits on boards are a good thing. As I leave, I know I'm one of the "old" ones. I remember when our camp wasn't in the best financial position. Calls asking which bills to pay are thankfully a thing of the past. New blood has the faith to take on huge projects like the much needed shower house. Today our camp is strong. We have tremendous leadership, and our staff from our Executive Director to our Camp Cook has hospitality and love spilling out of them. Our books are solid and our people that serve the camp are as committed as ever.

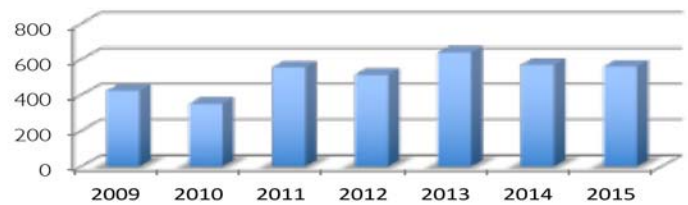
So I am sad to be leaving a board full of great people that have the ministry of Sky Ranch positioned for great things. It has been an honor to serve these past 8 years.

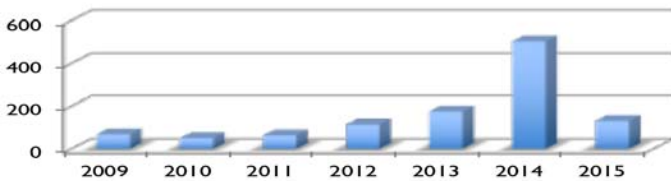
2015 CAMPER REGISTRATION

There were mixed camper trends in 2015, with elementary and middle school programs seeing a 14% increase and all high school programming significantly down due primarily to the ELCA Youth Gathering in Detroit. 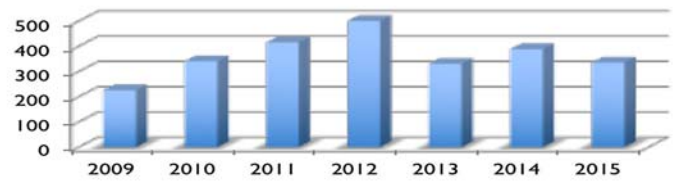
Main Ranch Programs

KATHRYN SEYFARTH – PROGRAM DIRECTOR

The summer of 2015 was a summer focused on “A Love that Never Ends” and exploring Love beyond Love. What would it look like if we loved radically, loved exuberantly, loved the way God calls us to Love in the most difficult times. This is a message I think our youth need to so desperately hear. In a world that is littered with judgement, expectations, materialism, popularity and survival of the fittest, a message of Love is the light in the darkness. What would it look like if our youth were to really hear this message of love and then pour that out into their own communities. An example I like to use for this is dropping a mentos into a diet coke bottle. When this tiny little mentos is dropped into a large bottle of diet coke it immediately shoots up into the sky and flows in every direction away from the bottle. We can sometimes feel like one single person, unable to create a reaction like that, but we never know the reaction we will have and how far it can reach until we immerse ourselves into God’s call to Love radically.

We had the opportunity to journey with five congregations to the ELCA National Youth Gathering in Detroit. On this trip youth groups went out into the neighborhoods of Detroit to clean what seems liked deserted homes. One particular youth group was dropped off in one of the most dangerous



neighborhoods of Detroit. About 30 minutes in, what they thought was a deserted neighborhood, began to come to life. Occupants of run down homes came out of their doors curious as to who these youth in orange shirts were and what they were doing in their backyard. They began to work alongside the youth in cleaning up their own neighborhood. An older woman spoke with one of the youth directors and said “Why are you here? We have been forgotten for 10 years and we had all but given up hope. You don’t even know us and yet you’re here cleaning our homes. I don’t know why you are here but you have given us hope again to continue to restore our neighborhood. I want you to know that

I love you guys.” For many of those kids they were scared, they were nervous and yet they moved beyond that to not only clean up a neighborhood but get to know the story of the residents and the vibrant history of Detroit that has been shadowed by violence and corruption. Imagine a world where we all live this out – that uncomfortable, sometimes scary love.

It all starts with the Cross. For God SO LOVED THE WORLD that he gave his only son for us. That is radical, exuberant love. As Richard Rohr says “Love by its very nature is freedom.” This was truly an incredible summer exploring this exuberant love that moves mountains.



ANDY SPRAIN – PROGRAM DIRECTOR

It is one of my favorite times of year: staff recruiting. It is when the vague outlines of summer start to take shape. It is when we get to talk most passionately about Sky Ranch and the unique opportunities that a summer of camping ministry presents. It is when we are surrounded by joyful young adults who are eagerly entering into vocational discernment and, with only a little trepidation, openly considering where God is calling them to serve. It is a time of rich conversation, great anticipation, and joyful celebration of Sky Ranch.

Some of my favorite conversations this time of year are with alumni staff who are considering a return for another summer of service. Not only are these conversations full of anecdotes of the power of camp and the many lives that are touched through our Sky Ranch ministry. But they also allow the returning staff **to wrestle with change:** the challenge of being open to a new community, new programs, and new

leadership expectations.

This summer saw many changes for Sky Ranch. Most noticeably was the deconstruction and reconstruction of our shower house – the first new building in over 30 years! Also significant was the expansion of staff with the addition of Dan, our summer maintenance coordinator. Many changes were less noticeable: the return of specifically hired summer program specialists, a new water filling station that meant not orange coolers in the lodge, and on-site credit card processing in the store.

One major change for me this fall was a move to part time hours at Sky Ranch while I attend Iliff School of Theology and pursue a Master of Theological Studies degree. Along side the move to part time was a role transition from Associate Director to Program Director working with High School and Marketing. In spring through summer I will resume full time hours to work with our Backpacking,



Rendezvous, and Service programs.

Just like our summer staff who are returning for their second, third, or fifth summer (Joe Rein, I am looking at you), change carries challenges and it can be difficult to be open to new opportunities. That said, it is wonderful to be part of an organization that embraces change. I am grateful for the way that Sky Ranch (board, staff, and ministry) approaches change with honesty, support, and a commitment to growth and excellence. As our board embarks on a comprehensive ministry review this spring, I look forward to watching change turn into transformation!

SKY RANCH 50TH ANNIVERSARY SPECIAL APPEAL

It may be fair to say that all of us have heard at one time or another that: "Cleanliness is next to Godliness". Hebrews 10:22 proclaims, "Let us draw near to God with a sincere heart and with the full assurance that faith brings, having our hearts sprinkled to cleanse us from a guilty conscience and having our bodies washed with pure water."

Sky Ranch has advanced this desire for cleanliness of body with the completion of the new \$430K shower house. On August 29th the Sky Ranch Community gathered to dedicate the new shower house. This event had been years in the making as the former shower house was built as a temporary solution 38 years ago. The celebration marked the completion of an important venture in the life of the ministry. We pray it will be a blessing to this ministry and last at least as long as its predecessor.

The shower house was a major part of the 50th Anniversary Special Appeal that started in the fall of 2013. While we continue to build our annual fund with gifts of all sizes, the Special Appeal seeks gifts of \$5,000 or more over a two to three-year period. The goal is to provide funding to replace the shower house and to reduce the camp's overall debt.

We currently have \$530,000 in pledges and gifts towards our goal of \$550,000!

The new shower house was built in two modular sections by Heritage Homes of Wayne, Nebraska. Upon completion, they were transported to Sky Ranch by Liscott Custom Homes. Demolition of the current shower house and site infrastructure was under the supervision of Thunderpup Construction of Fort Collins. The shower house has radiant heat in the floor and four showers, four

stalls, and three sinks on each side. It also has two Family bathrooms and a separate utility room. The barn doors can close to keep out the snow during the winter months.

Thank you to all who have gifted or pledged to this appeal. While over 95% of the money has been raised, we still have work to do. If you haven't given to the appeal, please consider a gift. Together, we will provide a great legacy to the future of Sky Ranch Lutheran Camp.
